Mae cymorth ar gael i oedolion sy'n byw yng Ngheredigion nad ydynt mewn cyflogaeth, addysg na hyfforddiant, ond mae ein prif ffocws ar gefnogi'r rhai sydd mwyaf wrth risg o fod dan anfantais.

Mae mentoriaid yn darparu cymorth un-i-un i gyfranogwyr wrth ysgrifennu CV, cynnal ffug gyfweiliadau, uwchsgilio ac ariannu amrywiaeth eang o hyfforddiant, gan gynnwys cymorth i ddechrau eu busnes eu hunain. Mae'r tîm yn edrych ymlaen at adeiladu ar y llwyddiant hwn ar gyfer y 12 mis nesaf i helpu trigolion Ceredigion i ddod o hyd i waith a lleihau tldi.

Gyda chymorth y prosiect, mae cyfranogwyr wedi dechrau cyflogaeth ac mae eraill wedi mynd i leoliadau gwirfoddoli, cyfleoedd gwaith â thâl neu hyfforddiant. Mae cyrsiau hyfforddi yn amrywio o gymwysterau cymorth cyntaf, manwerthu neu ofal iechyd, cardiau diogelwch adeiladu a hyd yn oed hyfforddiant gyrwyr HGV.

Support is available for adults living in Ceredigion who are not in employment, education, or training, however the primary focus should be to support those who are most at risk of disadvantage.

Mentors provide 1:1 support for participants, with writing CV's, undertaking mock interviews, up-skilling and funding to reduce a wide variety of barriers to employment. The team are looking forward to building on this success for the next 12 months to help residents of Ceredigion find employment and to reduce poverty.

With the support of the project, participants have entered employment and others have entered volunteering placements, paid work opportunities or completed training. Training courses range from First Aid qualifications, hospitality, retail, healthcare, and construction safety cards.

Hanes ein Llwyddiant Success Story



Mae Andrew yn ofalwr i'w wraig, ac roedd wrth ei fodd â'r syniad o fod yn yrrwr bus. Cyflawnodd yr uchelgais hwn ar ôl derbyn hyfforddiant hanfodol drwy gynllun Cymunedau am Waith+ (CFW+) Llywodraeth Cymru.

Yn dilyn blynyddoedd o hunangyflogaeth yn y diwydiant amaethyddol, cysylltodd Andrew â CFW+ ar ôl ariannu rhan cyntaf y cwrs ei hun. Doedd Andrew ddim yn gallu ariannu gweddill y cwrs ei hun gan ei fod yn rhoi straen ariannol ar ei deulu. Ariannodd Cynllun Llywodraeth Cymru CFW+ weddill yr hyfforddiant yn ogystal â'i brawf gyrru bus.

Darparodd CFW+ cefnogaeth llawn i Andrew drwy gydol ei daith. Cafodd ei swydd gyntaf fel gyrrwr bus gyda Midway Motors, yng Nghrymymch. I gymryd ei brawf gyrru, darparodd Midway Motors fws i Andrew a chynigwyd swydd iddo ar ôl pasio ei brawf. Cymerodd ran ym mhob sesiwn un i un gyda'i fentor, Rachel, a chwblhaodd ei holl dasgau.

Dyweddodd Rachel, ei fentor: "Roedd Andrew yn benderfynol i ddod yn yrrwr bus. Cwblhaodd bob tasg pan ofynnwyd iddo wneud hynny. Mae ganddo gymeriad gwych ac agwedd gadarnhaol at fod yn yrrwr bus. Edrychwn ymlaen at allu dweud 'Diolch, drive!' wrthyhych chi yn y dyfodol, Andrew."

Dyweddodd llefarydd ar ran Cyngor Sir Ceredigion: "Mae Andrew wedi dangos sut y gall cynllun fel CFW+ fod o fudd i bobl o bob oed. Mae ei agwedd gadarnhaol a'i barodrwydd i ddysgu, ynghyd â chefnogaeth gan dîm CFW+ wedi arwain at Andrew yn sicrhau swydd gwych fel gyrrwr bus. Os byddech chi, neu rywun rydych chi'n ei adnabod, yn elwa o gynllun CFW+ Llywodraeth Cymru, cysylltwch â ni am sgwrs."

Andrew is a carer for his wife, and loved the idea of being a bus driver. He met this ambition after essential training from the Welsh Government's Communities for Work+ scheme (CFW+).

Following years of self-employment in the agricultural industry, Andrew approached CFW+ having self-funded the first parts of his course. However, the remaining costs put financial strain on Andrew's family. Welsh Government's CFW+ scheme funded the remaining training as well as his bus driving test.

CFW+ supported Andrew throughout his journey, where he took his first job as a bus driver with Midway Motors, Crymymch, who provided Andrew with the bus for his test and employment upon passing his test. He took part in all one-to-one sessions with his mentor, Rachel, and completed all his tasks.

Rachel, his mentor, said: "Andrew showed passion and determination to become a bus driver. If he was tasked with something to complete, he did it immediately. He has a great character and positive attitude to be a bus driver. We look forward to being able to say 'Thanks, drive!' to you in the future, Andrew."

A Ceredigion County Council spokesperson said: "Andrew has demonstrated how a scheme such as CFW+ can benefit people of all ages. His positive attitude and willingness to learn, together with support from the CFW+ team has resulted in Andrew securing a great role as a bus driver. 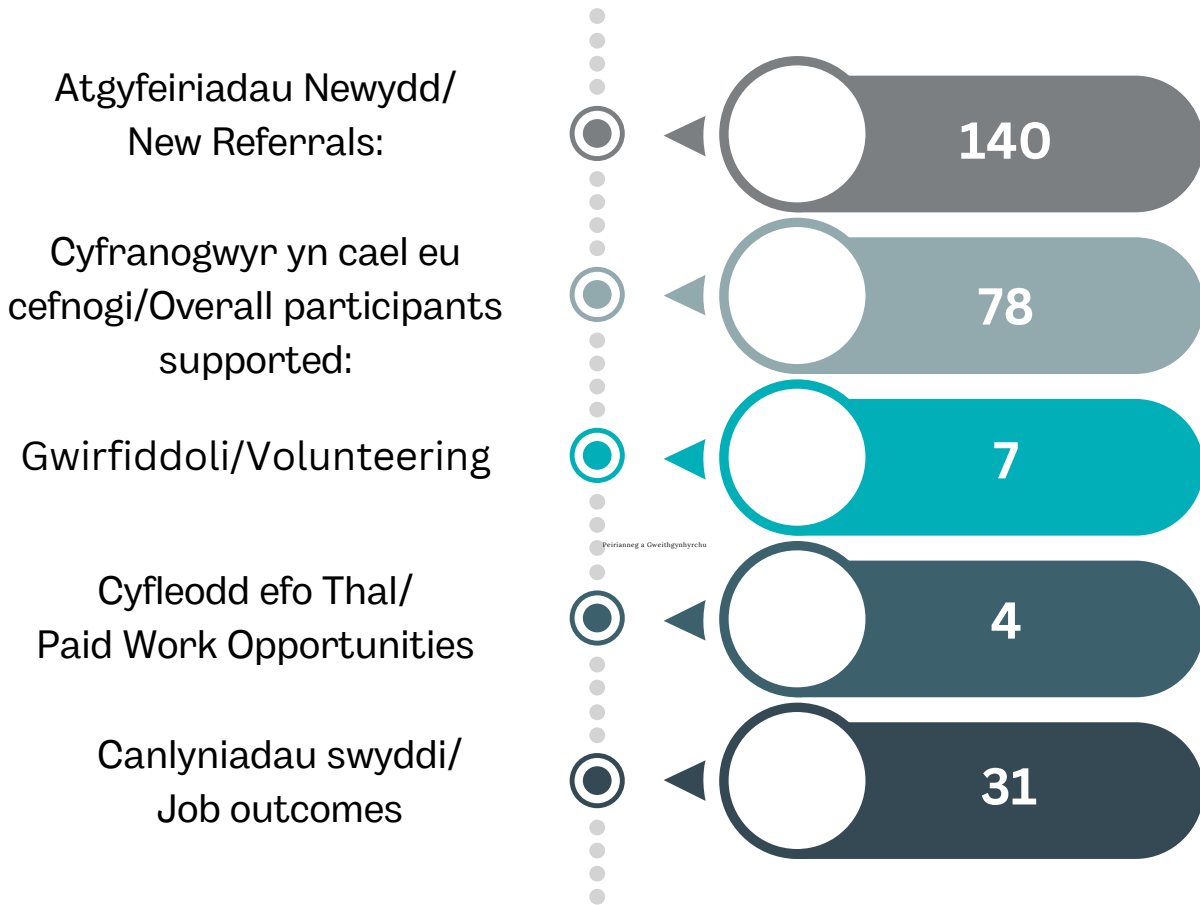
