## **Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions**

### **Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol**

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence—
  - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

### **Mandatory condition where the premises licence includes a Condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity:**

- (1) Each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (2) But nothing in (1) above requires such a condition to be imposed—
  - (a) in respect of premises within paragraph 8(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c. 12) (premises with premises licences authorising plays or films), or
  - (b) in respect of premises in relation to—
    - (i) any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence), or
    - (ii) any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act).
- (3) For the purposes of this section—
  - (a) “security activity” means an activity to which paragraph 2(1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and
  - (b) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule.

## **Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule**

### **Promotion of Licensing Objectives:**

- a. General – All four licensing objectives: Nothing entered in box.**
- b. Prevention of Crime and Disorder: No alcohol is sold on the premises. All events stewarded by members of committee.**
- c. Public Safety: Public Liability Insurance. Electrics checked under contract annually. Fire extinguishers checked by contract annually. First Aid Box, Emergency Lights.**
- d. Prevention of Public Nuisance: Hall situated at edge of village. No history of complaints. Entertainment ceases at reasonable hour.**
- e. Protection of Children from Harm: No alcohol is sold on premises. All functions stewarded by members of committee. Functions involving young children are supervised by their parents.**
