

Tactical Diversion Routes

PHYSICAL IMPLEMENTATION

Location

Action

- Erect 'ROAD AHEAD CLOSED' sign indicating alternative route symbol to follow on Northbound A487 at junction. Erect 'END OF DIVERSION' sign on A485 approach to junction.
- Erect direction signs from A485 to local road and onto B4343 and B4343 to local road and onto A485 at junction.
- 3. Erect conformation signs at junction with B4340
- Erect 'ROAD AHEAD CLOSED' sign to Westbound A4120 at junction. Erect direction signs from B4343 onto A4120 and A4120 onto B4343 at junction.
- Erect direction signs from A4120 onto A44 and from A44 onto A4120.
- Erect confiormation signs on A44 at lovesgrove roundabout. Erect direction sign for Northbound A487 to use A4179.
- Erect direction signage from A44 onto A4120 and from A4120 onto A44.
- Erect 'ROAD AHEAD CLOSED' sign indicating alternative route symbol to follow, on Southbound A487 at roundabout. Erect 'END OF DIVERSION' signs on B4120 approach to junction.

RISKS

- Traffic calming /Priority flow restrictions at Pontrhydfendigaid
- Livestock markets at Lovesgrove roundabout(Aberystwyth) & Tregaron

ROUTE DESCRIPTION

Ceredigion County Council control points at Llanfarian & Southgate Junction, Aberystwyth.



NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC

Divert onto A485 at Llanfarian, join the B4343 at Tregaron, at Devils Bridge take A4120, then onto A44 to Llanbadarn Fawr, take A4120 and rejoin A487 at Southgate Penparcau.

SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC

Divert onto A4120 at Southgate to Llanbadarn Fawr, then take A44 Eastbound take A4120 to Devils Bridge, then take the B4343 to Tregaron, take A485 and rejoin the A487 at Llanfarian.
