Ceredigion are this year's proud hosts of the Lloyds National Road Cycling Championships. Certain roads will be closed for periods of time during the period 26-29 June in Aberaeron and Aberystwyth.

Please see the information below to assist affected residents and businesses with specific information.

To see how your road will be affected, please check the maps which highlights affected streets.

All pavements will remain open at all times and so pedestrian access is maintained and welcomed. Any vehicles left on the highway on the race route (green/yellow on the map) including those in the designated parking bays will be towed away.. Crossing points are signified on the map (Aberystwyth route only).
