#### Flu and Covid Vaccinations for Unpaid Carers:

Did you know that unpaid carers are eligible for flu and COVID-19 vaccines this winter? Vaccination is one of the safest and most effective ways of preventing you and those you care for from getting seriously ill. #### Public Health Wales Bowel Screening Project:

Bowel Screening Wales are carrying out a project to look at improving the response from people who receive a bowel screening result saying blood has been found in their poo.

We are looking for small groups of people (approx. 6 - 8) aged 50 -74 to take part in focus groups to look over our bowel screening result and reminder information and answer some questions. The sessions will take approximately 1 hour 30 minutes. We can attend groups either in person or online.

We have a very tight time scale for the review of the letters and would like to engage before Christmas if possible.

#### Public Health Wales Lung Screening Project:

The Screening Division is undertaking a scoping project around the possible introduction of a national lung cancer screening programme in Wales.

This work is following a recommendation from the National Screening Committee, and is building on learning from a lung screening pilot which began in <u>Cwm Taf</u> <u>Morgannwg health board in 2023</u>.

We are currently planning our first phase of focus groups and surveys. We're keen to have feedback from a range of communities, with a focus on the likely target cohort for this programme – so we'd particularly like to engage with anyone aged 50-75, who is a current or ex-smoker.

Our ask:

- Focus groups of eligible service users aged 50- 75, who are smokers or exsmokers, all genders.
- Focus groups size would be ideally around 6-8 people. Our preference would be to tap into existing groups (social/support groups, coffee mornings etc) but we can probably help to co-ordinate if there are willing people.
- We would be looking to attend/hold these focus groups January/February time.
- Also, our online survey will be available to share soon
