

Active Journeys at Ysgol Bro Pedr

Ceredigion County Council were successfully awarded a grant by the Welsh Government 'Safe Routes in Communities Scheme' 2016-18 to undertake improvements in the vicinity of Ysgol Bro Pedr which were part funded by Lampeter Town Council. The scheme was implemented and also part-funded by Ceredigion County Council, which saw the introduction of a new 20 mph zone with traffic calming to help create a safer environment to encourage more pupils to walk, scoot and cycle to school.

These Active Travel journeys help the children to be healthier, prevent obesity, improve concentration and also help reduce vehicle congestion and carbon emissions outside the school gates.

The school is also part of Sustrans Wales 'Active Journeys Scheme' encouraging and enabling more children to travel to school by bike, scooter or on foot with the Eco Council playing an active role in implementing this aspect.



Thanks to the grant funding, new cycle and scooter shelters have been installed on school grounds.

Two new scooters and helmets have also been supplied to the school and pupils now have the opportunity to be 'Scooterer of the Week' as part of the school's 'Pupil of the Week'.

Wider footways with new surfacing and raised table crossings have been installed to aid mobility scooters and pushchair users.



We hope that continued community co-operation will help keep our school safe and healthy.
