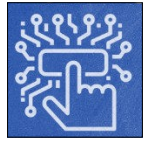
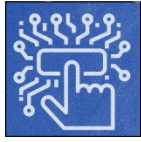

The Foundation Phase

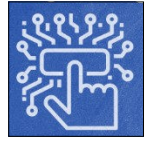
