Active Journeys at Ysgol Gynradd Aberteifi



Ceredigion County Council were successfully awarded a grant by the Welsh Government Local Transport Fund 2016/17 to undertake improvements in the vicinity of Cardigan Primary School which were part-funded by Cardigan Town Council. The scheme was implemented and also part-funded by Ceredigion County Council, which saw the introduction of a new 20 mph zone with traffic calming to help create a safer environment to encourage more pupils to walk, scoot and cycle to school.



These Active Travel journeys help the children to be healthier, prevent obesity, improve concentration within the classroom and also help reduce vehicle congestion and carbon emissions outside the school gates. The school has yet again been successful in achieving the prestigious platinum award from the Eco-Schools programme for their dedication and commitment to improving environmental and eco aspects within the school.

The school is also part of Sustrans Wales Active Journeys Scheme encouraging and enabling more children to travel to school by bike, scooter or on foot with the Eco Council playing an active role in implementing this aspect. Thanks to the grant funding, new cycle and scooter shelters have been

installed on school grounds which are proving so popular with the pupils that an extra scooter shelter has been installed.

Cardigan Primary School celebrate pupils' success regularly and with two new scooters and helmets being supplied pupils now have the opportunity to be 'Scooterer of the Week' as part of the school's 'Pupil of the Week'.



For those driving pupils to school please park responsibly in the car park or try parking further away from the school and walk the remainder of the journey.

Wider footways with new surfacing and raised table crossings have been installed to aid mobility scooters and pushchair users. A new path has also been installed to provide a safer route to the swimming pool.

We hope that continued community co-operation will help keep our school safe and healthy.
