## AMDANOM NI | ABOUT US

Mae cymorth ar gael i oedolion sy'n byw yng Ngheredigion nad ydynt mewn cyflogaeth, addysg na hyfforddiant, ond mae ein prif ffocws ar gefnogi'r rhai sydd mwyaf wrth risg o fod dan anfantais.

Mae mentoriaid yn darparu cymorth un-i-un i gyfranogwyr wrth ysgrifennu CV, cynnal ffug gyfweiliadau, uwchsgilio ac ariannu amrywiaeth eang o hyfforddiant, gan gynnwys cymorth i ddechrau eu busnes eu hunain. Mae'r tîm yn edrych ymlaen at adeiladu ar y llwyddiant hwn ar gyfer y 12 mis nesaf i helpu trigolion Ceredigion i ddod o hyd i waith a lleihau tldi.

Gyda chymorth y prosiect, mae cyfranogwyr wedi dechrau cyflogaeth ac mae eraill wedi mynd i leoliadau gwirfoddoli, cyfleoedd gwaith â thâl neu hyfforddiant. Mae cyrsiau hyfforddi yn amrywio o gymwysterau cymorth cyntaf, manwerthu neu ofal iechyd, cardiau diogelwch adeiladu a hyd yn oed hyfforddiant gyrwyr HGV.

Support is available for adults living in Ceredigion who are not in employment, education, or training, however the primary focus should be to support those who are most at risk of disadvantage.

Mentors provide 1:1 support for participants, with writing CV's, undertaking mock interviews, up-skilling and funding to reduce a wide variety of barriers to employment. The team are looking forward to building on this success for the next 12 months to help residents of Ceredigion find employment and to reduce poverty.

With the support of the project, participants have entered employment and others have entered volunteering placements, paid work opportunities or completed training. Training courses range from First Aid qualifications, hospitality, retail, healthcare, and construction safety cards.

# Hanes ein Llwyddiant

## Success Story



Cafodd Morgan ei gyfeirio at Dim Cymorth Cyflogadwyedd Cyngor Sir Ceredigion ym mis Medi 2023. Cafodd ei gofrestru ar gyfer y prosiect Cymunedau am Waith+ a ariennir gan Lywodraeth Cymru a dyrannwyd mentor cymorth Cyflogadwyedd.

Dangosodd Morgan frwdfrydedd tuag at wella ei ddyfodol ac roedd yn awyddus i sicrhau rôl barhaol yn y diwydiant adeiladu. Oherwydd ei ddiffyg profiad gwaith a'i gymhwyster perthnasol, profodd hyn i fod yn rhwystrol ond gyda chefnogaeth ei fentor, nodwyd mai cwblhau'r Cynllun Tystysgrif Sgiliau Adeiladu (CSCS) fyddai'r cam cyntaf. Dechreuodd Morgan ar ei gwrs Iechyd a Diogelwch CITB yn y diwydiant Adeiladu a llwyddodd i gael cerdyn gweithiwr.

Ar ôl cofrestru gyda nifer o asiantaethau adeiladu, nid llwyddodd Morgan i gael swydd. Yna cafodd ei gyfeirio at y swyddog Datblygu Cyflogaeth o fewn y tim i drafod yr opsiwn o gyflwynu gwaith â thâl a fyddai'n cael ei ariannu gan Gronfa Ffyniant Bro Llywodraeth y DU.

Roedd LJV Ltd, sydd ar hyn o bryd yn gweithio ar adnewyddu adeilad y Brifysgol ar bomenad Aberystwyth i ddod yn "ganolfan ddiwylliannol a chreadigol bwysig i Gymru" yn awyddus i gydwethio â'r Cyngor i a chynnig lleoliad gwaith i Morgan am 6 wythnos gyda'r bwriad o gael swydd barhaol yn dibynnu ar ei berfformiad.

Darparodd y Tim Cymorth Cyflogadwyedd gyfarpar diogelu personol (PPE) iddo cyn dechrau ar ei lleoliad gwaith a darparwyd cymorth parhaus trwy gydol yr amser.

Ym mis Mai 2024, dechreuodd Morgan yn ei lleoliad gwaith a ddaeth hyn i ben ganol mis Gorffennaf. Gan ei fod wedi dangos ymrwymiad a pherfformiad gwyb, cynigiwyd swydd barhaol i Morgan gyda LJV Ltd. Dywedodd: "Roedd y Cynllun yn well nag yr oeddwn i'n disgwyl. Mae'r tim cymorth cyflogadwyedd wedi rhoi swydd ran-amser am gyfnod penodol i mi sydd bellach wedi troi yn swydd llawn amser. Mae'r cynllun wedi rhoi'r cymwysterau a'r offer angenrheidiol i mi. Rwy'n falch o fod yn rhan o dîm LJV Ltd ac yn mwynhau bod yn rhan o amgylchedd gweithgar da."

Dywedodd Catherine, Mentor Morgan: "Fel tim, ni allem fod yn hapusach i Morgan a'r cynnydd y mae wedi'i wneud. Mae ei llwyddiant yn dangos effeithiolrwydd y prosiect o ran grymuso unigolion a meithrin cyfleoedd ystyrlon."

Dywedodd Shaun o LJV Ltd: "Mae Morgan yn weithiwr caled iawn. Mae'n gweithio'n dda o fewn y tim, ac mae bob amser yn rhoi ei gorau at y gwaith. Mae'n helpu'r bechgyn i gyd ac mae'n dysgu am bob agwedd o'r gwaith rydyn ni'n ei wneud."

Ychwanegodd y Cynghorydd Wyn Thomas, Aelod Cabinet Ceredigion sy'n gyfrifol am Ysgolion, Dysgu Gydol Oes a Sgiliau: "Mae hyn yn newyddion gwyb i Morgan, da iawn yn wir. O fis Ebrill 2024, mae'r tim Cymorth Cyflogadwyedd wedi cefnogi 47 o breswylwyr yng Ngheredigion i gael gwaith. Os ydych chi'n meddwl y gallech chi neu unrhyw un rydych chi'n ei adnabod elwa o'r cynllun, cysylltwch â'r tim."

Morgan was referred to the Ceredigion County Council's Employability Support Team in September 2023, where he was enrolled on to Welsh Government's funded project, Communities for Work+ and was allocated an Employability support mentor.

Morgan showed enthusiasm towards improving his future and was eager to secure a permanent role in the construction industry. Due to his lack of work experience and relevant qualification, this proved to be a barrier but with support from his mentor, it was identified that completing the Construction Skills Certification Scheme (CSCS) would be the first step in achieving his career goal.

Morgan was put forward for his CITB Health and safety course in Construction industry which he passed successfully and received his Labourer card.

Having registered with numerous construction agencies Morgan was still not successful securing a job. He was then referred to the Employment Development officer within the team to discuss the option of a paid work opportunity which would be funded by the UK Government Levelling up scheme.

LJV Ltd who are currently involved with the renovation of the University building on Aberystwyth promenade to become a "Major cultural and creative centre for Wales" were keen to work collaboratively with the Council and offered Morgan a work placement for 6 weeks with a view to a permanent position dependant on his performance.

The Employability Support Team provided him with personal protective equipment (PPE) prior to starting his placement and provided continued support throughout.

Morgan's placement started at the end of May 2024 and finished mid-July. After showing great commitment and performance, Morgan was offered a permanent position with in LJV Ltd which he accepted. He said: "The Scheme turned out to be better than I initially thought before I started, the employability support team provided me with a stable part time job that turned into a full-time job. The scheme has provided me with the qualifications and equipment needed. I'm happy being part of LJV Ltd and get along with everyone at the firm and enjoy being part of a good hard-working environment."

Catherine, Ceredigion Mentor said: "As a team, we couldn't be happier for Morgan and the progress he has made throughout his journey. His success showcases the project's effectiveness in empowering individuals and fostering meaningful opportunities."

Shaun at LJV Ltd, said: "Morgan is a very hard worker, he works well within the team, and he always gives 100%. He helps all the boys as much as he can, and he is learning about all aspects of the work that we carry out."

Councillor Wyn Thomas, Ceredigion's Cabinet member responsible for Schools, Lifelong Learning and Skills, added: "This is fantastic news for Morgan, well done indeed. From April 2024 to date, the Employability Support team has supported 47 residents in Ceredigion into employment. 


## September 2024
