

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## CEREDIGION COUNTY COUNCIL TOWN & POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847 (SECTION 21)

### LLANDYSUL & PONTWELI CARNIVAL 2025

---

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Ceredigion County Council has made the following Order under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 for the Prevention of Obstruction etc.

**WHEREAS** during certain hours between 13:30 hours and 14:15 hours on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> of July 2025 due to the above event taking place, that sections of roads known as Bridge Street (B4624), Wind Street (B4624), Lincoln Street (B4624), King Street (B4624), High Street (B4624), Lon Letty (B4624), Church Street (B4624) and UT25, Llandysul in the county of Ceredigion, will be thronged and liable to be obstructed.

Ceredigion County Council pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 DO HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT that for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said roads on the said day the following regulations shall be observed:-

1. Subject to those provisions contained in articles 4 and 5, the sections of roads known as Bridge Street (B4624), Wind Street (B4624), Lincoln Street (B4624), King Street (B4624), High Street (B4624) and UT25, Llandysul in the county of Ceredigion shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles between 13:30 and 14:15 hours on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> of July 2025. Each length of road will be closed for a short period at a time and re-opened as the parade progresses.
2. Subject to those provisions contained in articles 4 and 5, the sections of roads known as Lon Letty (B4624), Church Street (B4624), Llandysul in the county of Ceredigion shall be subject to long delays to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles, for no longer than 15 minutes, between 13:30 and 14:15 hours on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> of July 2025.
3. The alternative route for north-east traffic from a point south-west of the closure is to travel along Lewis Street to its junction with the B4336. Turn right onto the B4336 and travel to the roundabout. Take the second exit onto the A486 and travel to the next roundabout. Take the third exit onto the B4624 and continue into Llandysul and a point north-east of the closure. The alternative route is 3.5 mile in length.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

4. The provisions of article 1 & 2 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs and designated stewards.
5. Nothing in article 1 & 2 of this order shall apply to any vehicle being used by the emergency services, vehicles being used in connection with the events giving rise to this order, or anything done with the permission or under the direction of a police officer.

The penalty for infringement of the said Regulations is a fine not exceeding One Thousand Pounds.
