## **Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions**

### **Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol**

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
  - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

### **Mandatory condition where the premises licence includes a Condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity:**

- (1) Each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (2) But nothing in (1) above requires such a condition to be imposed—
  - (a) in respect of premises within paragraph 8(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c. 12) (premises with premises licences authorising plays or films), or
  - (b) in respect of premises in relation to—
    - (i) any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence), or
    - (ii) any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act).
- (3) For the purposes of this section—
  - (a) “security activity” means an activity to which paragraph 2(1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and
  - (b) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule.

## **Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule**

### **PROMOTION OF LICENSING OBJECTIVES:**

- a. General – All four licensing objectives:** All staff permitted to sell alcohol will be fully trained in the legal requirements for its sale as outlined below.
- b. Prevention of Crime and Disorder:** The sale of alcohol to anyone under the age of 18 will be strictly forbidden. Should there be any doubt of a persons age they will be required to present photographic evidence of identity. Alcohol will not be served to anyone displaying signs of being intoxicated.
- c. Public Safety:** As mentioned above alcohol will not be served to anyone showing signs of intoxication. All alcoholic beverages will be kept out of reach of children.
- d. Prevention of Public Nuisance:** We will do all that we can to protect the licensing laws and other businesses in the area. We will not be opening later than 10pm at any time.
- e. Protection of Children from Harm:** We will enforce a strict policy regarding the sale of alcohol to children. All persons causing suspicion will be subject to photo identification with details noted in an incident book.
