Project Name	Intervention	Summary
001SPF New 3G Pitches	W10 Comm & Place	The project is to create two new 3G Artificial Turf Pitches (ATPs) through upgrading the carpets on existing pitches at Cardigan and Synod Inn and also upgrade the existing halogen floodlights to LED floodlights that are more energy efficient. The pitches will be used by: education establishments during the day for curricular and extra-curricular activity, by the community in the evening and weekends - football and rugby team and other community clubs. Priority is to increase participation amongst women and girls.
002SPF North Facilities Feasibility Study	W14 Comm & Place	Ceredigion County Council and Aberystwyth University have agreed to undertake a joint feasibility study to provide a report that identifies the facility infrastructure required in the North of Ceredigion to meet the strategic aspirations of both organisations for improving the health & wellbeing of residents through being physically active, now and in the future.
003SPF Walking4Wellbeing	W6 Comm & Place	The West Wales Walking for Wellbeing project aims to develop a sustainable model for health and wellbeing walking groups across the Hywel Dda Health Board region that supports individuals who currently live sedentary or relatively sedentary lives, to become more physically active. The project offers non-strenuous walks that attract older people with various health conditions. Volunteers within communities are trained as Walk Leaders and the aim is after some support from the Walking Coordinator, the community volunteers will advertise, organise, and lead the walks with limited support from the project.
004SPF WBC Lampeter Fitness Equipment	W10 Comm&Place	The project is to equip the new Fitness Suite that is being created at Wellbeing Centre, Lampeter to enable 30 people (aged over 12yrs old) to be active at the same time.
005SPF Community Youth Work and Pathways Prog	W36 People & Skills	The project is an extension of the current delivery model within the Support and Prevention Service, which hosts three children and youth support teams. This project will focus on the community youth work and prevention team, which delivers a set of interventions for young people aged 16-25.
006SPF Sgilliau Bywyd, Sgilliau Gwaith	W35 People & Skills	The Sgilliau Bywyd Sgilliau Gwaith will have multiple interventions which will support People of all ages offering access to the development of skills, paid work experience/opportunities, in work support and training opportunities etc which will lead onto accreditation, qualifications and employment.
007SPF Events Partnership	W17 Local Business	The purpose of the project is to establish an events partnership for Ceredigion (The Caru Ceredigion Events Partnership - Partneriaeth Digwyddiadau Caru Ceredigion), and to support the delivery of two events in their early years in Ceredigion as part of building capacity to establish new events and attract recognised, established events to Ceredigion over the coming years.
